On Sunday evening Mr. J. I. Mudford spoke on 2 Corinthians viii. 9, and said that the deep motive that underlay the work of Christ was His grace. The essence of the word grace meant bestowing favour upon a person who was altogether deserving of something different. Paul gave Jesus His full title and that was the Lord Jesus Christ. There were some teachers who spoke of Jesus of Nazareth, but not as the Lord Jesus Christ. In the text the words, "He was" and "He became" were used, and they were significant. Christ had pre-existence with the Father, and He became poor. Jesus existed eternally as the word of God. Jesus Christ was rich, not in this world, but through all eternity. God stooped in the person of Jesus Christ to save the world, and that was the greatest stoop that the world ever knew.
